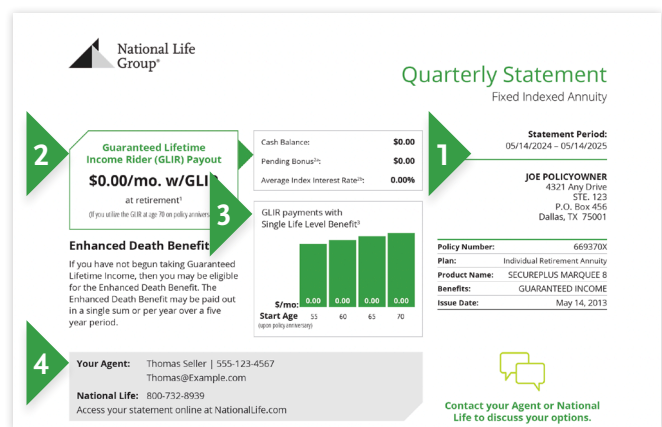
This section provides an overview of your guaranteed income benefit (if applicable) and a snapshot of your current account values as of the end of the statement period.

How to read the Annuity Statement — Page 1

- 1 Customer Profile & Policy Information**
This area lists your personal information and the key details about your annuity. It includes your name and mailing address for verification, along with:
- **Statement Period:** The start and end dates covered by this statement.
 - **Policy Number:** The unique number assigned to your annuity.
 - **Plan:** The type of plan.
 - **Benefits:** Any active key benefits or riders associated with your annuity.
 - **Product Name:** The specific annuity product you own.
 - **Issue Date:** The date your annuity was issued.

- 2 Key Account Values**
Summary of your account activity for the period:
- **GLIR Payout:** This box shows your projected Guaranteed Lifetime Income Rider (GLIR) monthly payout amount.
 - **Cash Balance:** The gross value of your annuity at the end of the statement period.
 - **Pending Bonus:** If your product includes a bonus feature, this displays any bonus amount that has been earned but not yet applied.
 - **Average Index Interest Rate:** This shows the weighted average interest rate credited across all of your indexed strategies for the period.

- 3 GLIR Payments with Single Life Level Benefit**
This chart shows how monthly GLIR payments may vary depending on the age you begin taking lifetime income.
- Each bar represents a different start age
 - Payment amounts are based on your contract's benefit calculation rules
 - This helps you compare potential income options at future ages

4 Cash Balance

The gross value of your annuity at the end of the statement period.

5 Income Balance

This amount represents the value used to determine the guaranteed lifetime income benefit payment. It is available only as retirement income under your contract.

6 Death Benefit

This is the amount your beneficiaries will receive if the annuitant passes away. It helps you understand the protection your annuity provides to those you name as beneficiaries.

7 Surrender Value

This is the amount you can withdraw if you choose to surrender your contract, minus any applicable charges or taxes.

8 Statement Period Details

This table summarizes all activity within the statement period, including:

- **Beginning Value:** Your account value at the start of the period
- **Credited Interest:** Interest earned during the period
- **Bonus Vested:** If your product includes a bonus, this shows the portion of the bonus that became vested during this period.
- **Withdrawals:** Any amounts taken out
- **GLIR Charge (if applicable):** The cost of the Guaranteed Lifetime Income Rider
- **Ending Value:** Your account value at the end of the period

9 Allocations

This section shows how your money is allocated within your indexed strategy.

10 Policy Interest Rates

This section shows the maximum interest rate, participation rate, and floor (minimum possible interest credit) for each indexed strategy.

11 Protect Your Assets
